B.Sc. (HONS.) NURSING ADMISSIONS, 2018-2019

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. The counseling of candidates seeking admission to B.sc (Hons.) Nursing course at R.A.K. College of Nursing for the session, 2018-19 will be held at the **R.A.K. College of Nursing** itself as per schedule given below:

1 st DAY OF COUNSELING	09th July , 2018 at 10:00 a.m.	OBC (CATEGORY RANK 9 to 46) SC (CATEGORY RANK 2 to 30)
2 nd DAY OF COUNSELING	10th July , 2018 at 10:00 a.m.	COMBINED (RANK 1 to 20) GENERAL (CATEGORY RANK 17 to 59)
3 rd DAY OF COUNSELING	11th July , 2018 at 10:00 a.m.	ST (CATEGORY RANK 1 to 14), EX-SERVICEMAN (CATEGORY RANK 1 to 11)

NOTE :-

- ❖ Candidates should report at 10AM on the day of counseling.
- ❖ If the candidate fails to report when called for counseling their candidature will be cancelled and next candidate will be called.

2. Allocation of seats will be done in following manner:

a) General	- 27 seats	e) Foreign	- 03 seats
b) OBC	- 19 seats	f) PH	- 02 seats
c) SC	- 10 seats	g) Ex-serviceman	- 03 seats
d) ST	- 05 seats		

After the available seats are filled in all the categories, rest of the candidates will be kept in the waiting list of respective categories.

3. The admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit to be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in B.Sc. (H) Nursing Entrance Test, 2018. If the candidates have same Entrance test marks then merit will be decided on CBSE 12th marks (PCBE). If more than one candidates fall in same rank then further merit will be decided as per date of birth.

4. Candidates who have been called for counseling are required to bring with them two Demand drafts / Pay orders of **Rs.9,060/- & Rs.3,455/-** respectively in favour of **“PRINCIPAL, R. A. K. COLLEGE OF NURSING”** payable at **New Delhi**.
5. Candidates belonging to SC and ST Category, whose parent's income is such that they are not paying Income Tax, are exempted from the payment of Tuition Fee. However, a declaration to that effect will have to be given in writing by the parents seeking exemption.
6. Fee has to be deposited by the selected candidates **on the day of counseling itself**. Candidates who fail to fulfill the admission formalities or do not deposit the fee on the day of counseling will lose their claim for the admission.
7. At the time of counseling/allotment of seats for the B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing course, the candidates will have to bring the following certificates/documents in original:
 - a. **Secondary School Examination (10th) certificate** as a proof of date of birth / Date of Birth certificate.
 - b. **Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2)** or equivalent Examination certificate and mark-sheet with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of 4 subjects including English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology provided the student has passed in each subject separately.
 - c. **Schedule Caste/ Schedule Tribe/OBC certificate (non-creamy layer)** if applicable.
 - d. **Certificate of good conduct 2018** from the educational institute last attended or by a Gazatted officer.
 - e. **Admit card of selection test 2018**.
 - f. **Three passport size photographs** as pasted on the application form/admit card.
 - g. **One set of self- attested copies of all the above documents**.
 - h. **Affidavit by the Parents**.
 - i. **Affidavit by the students**.
 - j. **Candidates seeking admission against reserved seats for Physically Handicapped** would be required to bring with them the original Medical Certificate issued to them by an authorized Medical Board.
 - k. **Candidates seeking admission against reserved seats for wards of Ex-Servicemen** are required to bring the original certificate issued to their parents by the competent authority.

8. No candidates will be allowed to attend the counseling without bringing original certificates.
9. It is mandatory for all candidates to be present in person along with their parents / Guardians for counseling on the prescribed day. No request for allowing any authorized representative on behalf of candidates will be entertained. If a candidate fails to come for counseling in person, she will be marked absent and her candidature will be cancelled.
10. Candidates will have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay in New Delhi for attending the counseling.
11. All the original documents of the finally selected candidates will be kept in the College record.
12. All admissions are subject to verification of authenticity of the original certificates / documents of the candidates. The decision of the admission committee regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.
13. After admission, the selected candidates will be required to undergo a Medical Examination and their admission will be confirmed only if they are found medically fit.
14. Candidates, finally selected for admission to B.Sc. (H) Nursing course will be allotted accommodation in the Students' Hostel of the College where they will be provided with Cot, Writing Table and Chair. Hostel accommodation (on twin sharing basis) will be available from **19th July 2018 onwards**. Mess will start operating w.e.f. **20th July 2018** only. **Staying in hostel is compulsory for all B.Sc. (H) Nursing students.**
 - **No separate letter for attending COUNSELING will be sent to the candidates. Candidates may see their result displayed at the College Notice Board or by visiting our College Website 'www.rakcon.com' on 02th July, 2018 at 12:00 Noon**
