IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES REPORTING FOR ADMISSION

- 1. All the Candidates who have been allotted seats at R.A.K. College of Nursing by MCC, DGHS are required to bring the following original documents at the time of reporting for admission:
 - a) Provisional Allotment letter by MCC.
 - b) Rank letter and Result (both)
 - c) NEET Admit Card
 - d) Identity Proof : Adhaar Card/Voter ID
 - e) Secondary School Examination (10th) certificate as a proof of date of birth / Date of Birth certificate
 - f) Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2) or equivalent Examination certificate and mark-sheet with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of 4 subjects including English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology provided the student has passed in each subject separately (Practical & Theory).
 - g) Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ EWS certificate issued by competent authority if applicable. The validity of the non-creamy layer and EWS certificate shall be for the financial year 2023-24, issued after 31st March, 2023.
 - h) Certificate of recent good conduct 2023 from the educational institute last attended or by a Gazetted Officer.
 - i) Two passport size photographs as pasted on the application form/admit card.
 -) One set of self- attested copies of all the above documents.
 - k) * Anti-ragging Affidavit by the Parents/Guardian
 - 1) * Anti-ragging Affidavit by the students. Students are to fill online <u>undertaking</u> on the link https://www.antiragging.in/affidavit_registration_disclaimer.html and bring the acknowledgement copy of same for submission at college.
 - m) Candidates seeking admission against reserved seats for PwD should bring with them the original Medical Certificate issued to them by an authorized Medical Board.
 - n) Candidates seeking admission against reserved seats for wards of Ex-Servicemen are required to bring the original certificate issued to their parents by the competent authority in prescribed performa.
- 2. Candidates who have been called for admission are required to bring with them two Demand drafts / Pay orders of Rs.9990/- & Rs.13455/-(Hostler) and Rs. 7990/- & Rs.

255/- (Non-Hostler) respectively in favour of "PRINCIPAL, R. A. K. COLLEGE OF NURSING" payable at New Delhi.

- 3. Candidates belonging to SC and ST Category, whose parent's income is such that they are not paying Income Tax, are exempted from the payment of Tuition Fee. However, a declaration to that effect will have to be given in writing by the parents seeking exemption.
- 4. Fee has to be deposited by the selected candidates on the day of reporting. Candidates who fail to fulfill the admission formalities or do not deposit the fee on the day of reporting will lose their claim for the admission.
- 5. It is mandatory for all candidates to be present in person along with their Parents/Guardians while reporting to the Institute for admission.
- 6. Candidates will have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay in New Delhi while reporting to the Institute for admission.
- 7. All admissions are subject to verification of authenticity of the original certificates / documents of the candidates, if any discrepancy is found, the allotted seat and admission will be cancelled. The decision of the admission committee regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.
- 8. The candidates are requested to visit the website www.mcc.nic.in Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India and www.rakcon.com regularly for updated information.
- 9. No individual communication will be sent for the admission.
